**Entry Packets Must Include the Following:**

- Show Jumping Rally Competitor Information Form 2011
- Proof of Negative Coggins - valid through rally date
- Uniform Chaperone Rules – one per team
- Guidelines for Coaching – one per team
- Team Entry Form – one per team

**Fees:**

\$170.00 per rider (\$140 per rider in Delightful D Division) includes initial stall bedding, grounds fees, awards, a very nice t-shirt, and breakfast and lunch for both days.

Horse manager fee is \$50.00.

Stall deposit of \$25 required per rider. DC will send in separate club checks for entire team deposit.

Volunteer Deposit of \$25 required per rider. DC will send in separate club check for entire team deposit.

**Additional Fees - Changing Divisions/Late/Incomplete Entries:**

1. Changes requested on or after 4/02/11 will require \$5 per change.
2. Requests must be in writing/email from the DC - no phone changes!
3. **Entries:** Late entries will be assessed \$5.00 per entry; \$5 per missing or outdated Coggins and \$5.00 for each missing or incomplete form. If Coggins expires between closing date and rally date, a new Coggins must be received prior to rally but no change fee will be incurred.

**Stalls:**

Entry fee includes stabling for Friday and Saturday nights. If an additional night is desired, it must be noted on the entry form and paid (\$25/night) along with the entry. Stalls are permanent wood with initial bedding. If any stall, INCLUDING THE TACK STALL is left dirty or unacceptable according to current USPC HM practices, the entire team forfeits its stall deposit.

**Meals:**

Pastries, Juice and Coffee will be available each morning for all competitors and at the volunteer meetings. Lunch will be provided to all rally participants.

**Teams:**

Teams will consist of 3 or 4 riders and a **REQUIRED stable manager**. Mixed rating level teams are encouraged. Your DC will coordinate with the rally secretary those individuals to be placed on a regional scramble team. Each team must have a chaperone and a coach.

**Delightful D Teams:**

The Delightful D division will be made up with riders 10 years and under who are new to the rally experience and that the DC would like to have more support than a traditional team offers. These teams must have an older Stable Manager as well as a C advisor and will be a separate division competing against other Delightful D teams. The Horse Management will focus on teaching opportunities and the overall experience will be focused on learning and having a relaxed atmosphere.

**Member Requirements:**

All members who have paid 2011 regional dues may participate with the approval of their club DC. You must compete at your current rating as of closing date of the Rally.

**Courses: Four Rounds.** The equitation round will be the second ride for all heights. The third round in Pea Green and up will be a Take Your Own Line ride. The remaining heights (18 inch, crossrails and poles) will have a normal knock-down course for all four rounds. Only the last three rounds will be used in determining qualifying scores.

Sm/Med Pony 2' – 2'9"  
Large Pony 2'6" – 3'3"  
Developing Horse or Rider Division – 2'9" - 3'  
Horse I 2'6" – 3'3"  
Horse II 2'9" – 3'6"  
Horse III 3' – 3'9"  
Horse IV 3'3" – 4'

**The DC is responsible for ensuring proper jumping levels for rider and horse/pony.**

We will be using three rings for this rally. The 18 inch, crossrails, and poles will be in a grass over sand ring for all four rides. All other rides will be in the two sand/clay rings.

Items accepted for resale include, but are not limited to: saddles, other tack, riding clothing, boots, crops, "horsey" clothing, horse boots, bandages, stable equipment, buckets, horse blankets, horse books, horsey art, and so on. Please be sure items are in safe and presentable condition. We will NOT accept helmets of any kind, however. Helmets should never be purchased used because it is impossible to accurately determine the integrity/safety of a used helmet.

- 6.) If you must leave the rally before noon Sunday, please provide us with a self addressed stamped envelope to mail your check and inventory to you. Any unsold items will be sent home with your designated representative that you send to us to pick them up. No checks can be issued early! Sorry!
